## **Agenda Items:**

Item one will be a proposal to apply for funding for Safe Routes to School Infrastructure. Estimates are included for this proposal.

Item two will be an update from the MPO on the Functional Classification Revisions. Information was included in the memo last week.

Item three will be a request from the City Engineers for the permission to complete project that would include taking out the spur line that goes across 5<sup>th</sup> Ave NE and lower the street so it is level with the rest of the street.

Item four will reconsider the extension to the fire contract between the City of East Grand Forks and the neighboring townships. The revisions have been made and okayed by the townships.

Item five is more information from Mr. Larson on the MN Four-wheel trail which answers some of the questions the Council. He is formally asking the Council to be the sponsor for this project and included the Legacy application. Mr. Larson will not be attending this meeting.

Item six will consider approving an extension to the contract between the City of East Grand Forks and Northland Community and Technical College for continued use of the public parking lot for their truck driving program.

Item seven will consider giving the non-union workers a 2% cost of living increase. This is the same amount the four union groups will be receiving.
