## **Update from Administrator:**

### **Point of Woods 5<sup>th</sup> Addition**

Bob Peabody of Lumber Mart met with staff and is requesting that the City consider using end benefit calculations to spread the cost of the assessment. He also will be protesting the inclusion of the 40' right of way in the assessment of the Lovejoy property. Mr. Peabody made the statement that he was not paid for that easement and it is the responsibility of the City as a whole.

## **Department Update:**

### **Public Works Department**

**Sorlie Bridge Project:** The Sorlie Bridge rehabilitation project will be starting June 15<sup>th</sup>, with a completion date of no later than October 14<sup>th</sup>. North Dakota DOT is the lead for the project, of which will consist of re-decking, painting, and installing new lighting. There will be only one lane of traffic on the bridge for the duration of the project. They will be working on the south side of the bridge first, and when complete will allow traffic to flow on that side while they start working on the north side.

**Mosquitoes:** This past Tuesday we along with Grand Forks performed our first mosquito ground spray of the season. The results of the spray were positive. The mosquito trap count on Tuesday (morning prior to spraying) was 87. Wednesday morning following the spray the trap count was 12.
