Department Update:

Public Works Department

Sorlie Bridge Project: The Sorlie Bridge is now reduced to one lane. The flow of traffic through the project area has been moving surprisingly well. The contractors have been working on a lot of prep work this week, and expect to have all over their equipment here by Friday (6/19).

Mosquitoes: We sprayed for mosquitoes last Friday. That was our second spray of the season, and once again appeared to be a successful spray.

Stormwater: We have been working on cleaning and televising our stormwater line that runs under Northland Tech Parking lot. So far we have found that there are several pipe joints that need repairs. We are having more of the line televised next week. After we review all of the televising we will make up repair/replacement plans.

Wastewater: MN Pump Works is up this week performing our annual pump inspection.

Streets: All State and Federal Aid streets were striped last week. OPP construction will be striping all stop logs, turn arrows, and rail road crossings within the next couple of weeks.

We installed two signs on Bygland Rd. near the intersection of Bygland and Greenway Boulevard. The signs were purchased by Altru's Safe Kids and are intended to warn drivers to watch for pedestrians.
