Department Update:

Public Works – Jason Stordahl

Mosquitoes: This past Tuesday we completed our second spray of the year. Spray efforts seem to be working well, trap counts went from in the 40's on Tuesday morning down to single digits after the spray.

Stormwater: We found another separation in some storm sewer west of Northland Community and Technical College. We are televising this week, once that is complete we will assess the damage and come up with a plan to repair.

Wastewater: Staff received the 2015 Wastewater Treatment Facility Operational Award from MPCA. This award recognizes exemplary effort expended to comply with the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency's NPDES/SDS Permit Program.

The Interconnect Project is out for bid, with a bid opening date scheduled for July 7th.

Lift Station 5 construction is moving right along. All underground electrical is installed, and they are set to pour the roof this week.

Streets: The pre-construction meeting for our Mill/Overlay project is set for next Tuesday.
Striping: MNDOT has had a few setbacks with their striping crew, but told me that they would be here early next week to stripe our State Aid Streets.

We are awaiting the delivery of our new street sweeper, which was scheduled to be delivered on Thursday, June 23rd.
