## **Department Update:**

### **Public Works – Jason Stordahl**

#### **Streets:**

Street Improvement Project- Strata has completed the mill and overlay portion of the project. They are now working on the reconstruction of the intersection of 3<sup>rd</sup> street NE and Central Avenue. They are set to start seal coating next week.

Riverview Lane- All the paving is complete.

Lowering of 5<sup>th</sup>- All concrete work is complete and the road has been open to traffic for about 15 days now.

**Mosquitoes:** We are still seeing high mosquito numbers, and had another report of West Nile in a collected bird specimen. Staff sprayed for mosquitoes on Wednesday the 31<sup>st</sup>, and will be spraying again this Friday weather permitting.

#### **Wastewater:**

Lift 5- The contractor is working on the installing pumps and controls at the lift station. Our goal is to be up and running by September 25<sup>th</sup>.

Interconnect- The excavation for the lift station is complete, and ICS plans on pouring the base sometime this week. Zavoral's are set to start stripping the black dirt from the borrow pit area on Friday, so that they can begin drying out the clay that lies beneath.

#### **Stormwater:**

CORPS Inspection- ARMY CORPS Inspectors were up for a few days this month inspecting the levees, lift stations, and structures. All appears to be in good shape.
