Cold Weather Rule Annual Notice

The Minnesota Cold Weather Rule is designed to protect people who may have trouble paying their utility bills in the winter. The Minnesota Cold Weather Rule applies from Oct. 1st to April 30th.

The rule means that your utility cannot disconnect your residential electric service during the winter if the customer meets the following 4. Customer enters and requirements:

- 1. Disconnect would affect the primary heat source.
- Customer has declared inability to pay on the form provided by the
- 3. Customer's total household income is less than 50% of the state median income.
- makes reasonably timely payments under a

payment agreement that considers the financial resources of the household.

Address Numbers

In an effort to ensure a timely response to emergency situations in the City of East Grand Forks. The East Grand Forks Fire Department would like to inform you of the requirements of displaying address numbers on your home, apartment building or business. These requirements are from the 2020 Minnesota State Fire Code which applies to all structures-residential, commercial, private and public.

PREMISES IDENTIFICATION

MSFC 505.1 Address Identification:

New and existing buildings shall have approved address identification. The address identification shall be legible and placed in a position that is visible from the street or road fronting the property.

- The numbers shall be visible from the street or road fronting the property.
- The numbers shall contrast with their background.
- The numbers shall not be spelled out.
- Each number shall not be less than 4 inches high.
- Each number shall have a minimum stroke width of ½ inch.
